

# Training on Chinese Language and Culture in Shanghai, China

#### • What is the training about?

- Chinese language immersion class and practical activities
- Chinese culture workshop/experience
- Scenic-spot visiting

### • When and where?

Normally it is 10 days programe starting at the end of July at Institute of Global Chinese Language Teacher Education of East China Normal University, Shanghai, China

#### • How much does the training cost?

- All costs are covered EXCEPT:
  - □ International flights and transportation between Shanghai airport and the hotel.
    - \* Free coach pick-up from airport to hotel for group over 15 people
- The costs covered:
  - $\checkmark$  Tuition fees
  - ✓ Textbook fees
  - ✓ Hotel accommodation (2 persons per room sharing) from 22<sup>nd</sup> July till 3<sup>rd</sup> August
    \* By paying price difference, you can have a room of your own

#### • What certificate will I receive?

On completion of this teacher-training programme, the Institute of Global Chinese Language Teacher Education of East China Normal University will award a certificate.

#### • Who are eligible to apply?

Applicants shall be Chinese language teachers from overseas main universities, colleges and schools who are under the age of 60 and in good health conditions.

## • How to apply?

Please apply online (*http:// kzxylocalteacher.hanban.org*) before 30<sup>th</sup> April this year. The UCD Confucius Institute, as recommendation unit, will then submit your application after verifying your eligibility.

## • When can I know if my application has been approved?

The Headquarters will process your application once it is submitted by UCD Confucius Institute. Decision will be made mainly based on your Chinese teaching experience or prospect. Once your application is approved, the host university in Shanghai will send out invitation letter. (Last year, invitation letters were sent out before end of June.) Please do NOT make any travel arrangement until your application is approved.
